4. MONETARY DONATION TO THE DISTRICT
Susan Jenkins presented a motion, seconded by Mark Schneider to accept a \$2500 grant from the Brenham Elks Lodge #979 to be used for a 3D printer upgrade as presented. The motion passed with a vote of seven for and none opposed.

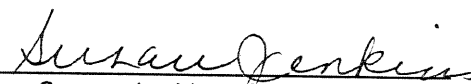
10. PUBLIC PARTICIPATION
