Intern Application Packet

Thank You for your interest in Project SEARCH. This program is offered to transition students based on an application process. Project SEARCH is a transition to work program lasting one school year. The program serves students with intellectual and developmental disabilities who would benefit from an intensive year of career development, internship experience, and support to reach their employment goals. Project SEARCH is for students whose goal is competitive employment in an integrated setting for a minimum of 16 hours per week. The program host business is Baylor Scott & White Healthcare in Brenham, Texas. The Interns are totally immersed in the workplace which facilitates employability and marketable work skills.

Project SEARCH Entrance Criteria

- Must be at least 18 years of age
- Desire and plan to work competitively in the community at the conclusion of the Project
 SEARCH Program
- Have completed high school credits necessary for graduation before beginning program
- Meet eligibility requirements & be enrolled in Vocational Rehabilitation Services, Texas
 Workforce Solutions
- Have Individualized Education Plan
- Agree that this will be the last year of student services
- Have independent personal hygiene and grooming skills
- Have independent daily living skills
- Maintain appropriate behavior and social skills in the workplace
- Take direction from supervisors and instructor and make changes to behavior based on feedback
- Be able to communicate effectively
- Be able to pass a drug screen, background check
- Provide own transportation to work site
- Have required immunizations up to date
- Agree to participate in Project SEARCH which is a non paid internship









Application Purpose & Guidelines

The purpose of this application is to give an informed picture of the Project SEARCH candidate. The information collected in this application enables the selection committee to properly assess each candidate's skills, and abilities. Our goal is to select students who will be successful in a Project SEARCH program and reach the outcome of Competitive Employment.

Steps to Project SEARCH and Employment

- 1. Submit completed application by March 18, 2025
 - a. Angela Moore, Project SEARCH Coordinator, at Baylor Scott & White Hospital
 - b. Christy Van Dyke, Transition Coordinator, at Brenham ISD
 - c. Miranda Meier, Vocational Rehabilitation Services Counselor, at Texas Workforce

2. All Students and Parents are encouraged to attend an Open House/Information meeting, take a tour of the host business site to observe the culture, and meet with the Instructor and Skills Trainers prior to being selected to participate in Project SEARCH.

3. Complete Project SEARCH application, Apply to Texas Workforce and meet all eligibility requirements

4. The Selection Committee will review the applications and will schedule Interviews

If selected, the student will need to provide the following information to Project SEARCH

- Proof of Health Insurance
- Photo
- Copy of State ID or Driver's License
- Consent for background check
- Consent for drug screen
- Completion of immunizations/ vaccines required by Baylor Scott & White Hospital

• Copy of shot/immunization records









Students who have not completed the necessary requirements will not be permitted to participate in our Brenham Project SEARCH Program.

Please Note: The Selection Committee will include the Host Site Liaison, the Project SEARCH Coordinator, Project SEARCH Skills Trainer, Project SEARCH School District Liaison, Project SEARCH representatives from TEXAS WORKFORCE Solutions, and Project SEARCH representatives from Brazos Valley Center for Independent Living.

Order of selection:

- 1. Students who have finished their necessary credits for graduation
- 2. Students who will benefit from participation in a variety of internships
- 3. Students who desire to gain competitive employment at the end of the Project SEARCH Program.
- 4. Students who have been accepted to TEXAS WORKFORCE SOLUTIONS.

Required Immunizations for Interns

Below are the required immunizations for interns attending Project SEARCH at Brenham Baylor Scott & White Hospital. Interns must complete all immunizations before they will be allowed to attend Project SEARCH Internships at the Hospital.

Please note that this list may change if/when hospital requirements change

Required Vaccinations:

- □ Tuberculosis- TB blood test or TB skin Test (2 negative readings at least one week apart)
- □ Hepatitis B- HBV3-step vaccination or positive titer
- □ Measles/Mumps/Rubella- MMR 2 step vaccination or positive titer
- Chicken pox Varicella 2-step vaccination or positive titer(History of varicella requires titer)
- Tetanus toxoid, reduced diphtheria toxoid, and acellular pertussis -Tdap vaccination
 administered over the age of 18
- □ Influenza /Flu vaccination during flu season (October March)

All intern's vaccination records will be reviewed and verified by the Baylor Scott & White employee health nurse. Interns and families will be notified when the intern is medically cleared to work at the hospital.











Vaccination records must be submitted to Angela Moore (<u>amoore@brenhamk-12.net</u>) **no later** than July 12, 2025. This allows sufficient time for the employee health nurse to review records,

Drug test, Background check, and TB test, will be done 2 weeks before the first day of our Project SEARCH program.
